15% of these training courses are focused for unemployment people.


CECE contains about 2.000

CECE produces the contents for the courses along with VET Centres professionals to increase the quality and application of them.




The Educational Techniques Institute of CECE

This Institute was created by an agreement in co-operation with the Ministry of Education to provide training for all the staff implicated in the Educational sector. It provides:




