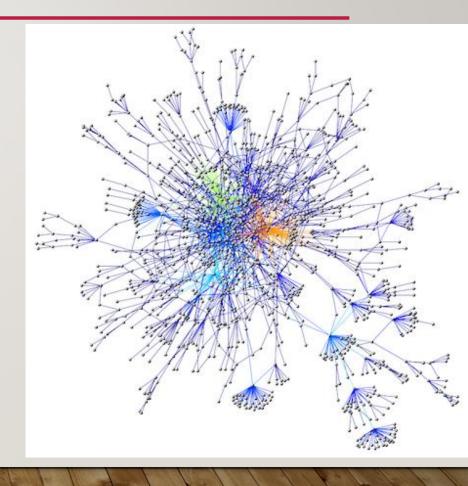
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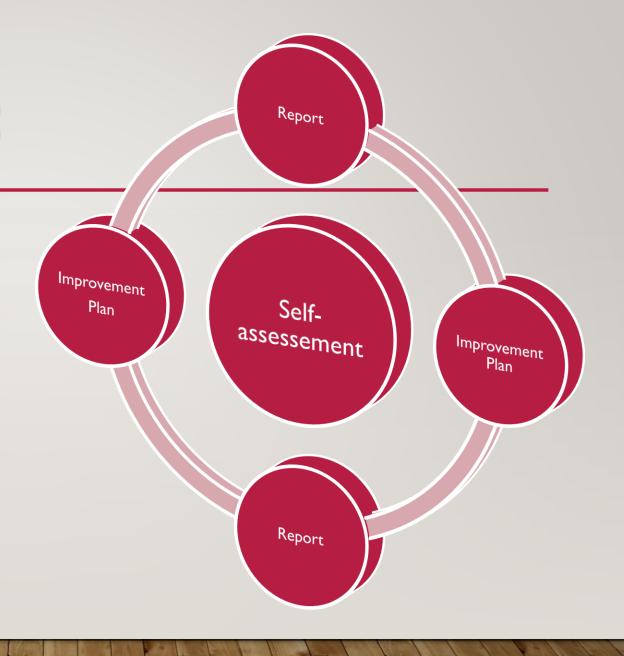
#### 1. The Problem

- STUDENTS: I survey per class from the primary to secondary school (49)
- TEACHERS: I survey by:
  - delegates of curricular group (22)
  - coordinator of curricular department (6)
  - establishment coordinator (4)
  - coordinator of class directors (3)
  - coordinator of professional courses (1)

  - OPERATIONAL ASSISTANTS (10)
  - TECHNICAL ASSISTANTS (I)
  - DIRECTION (I)

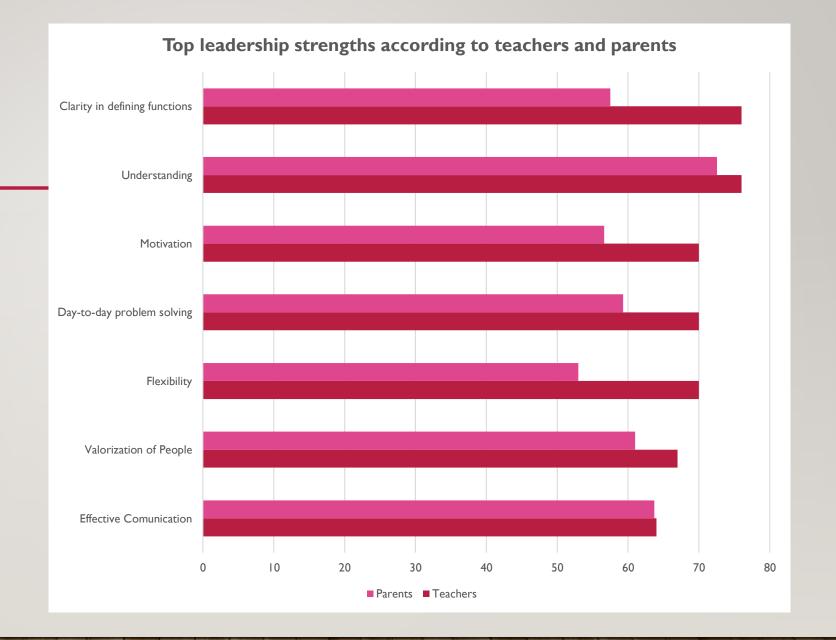


#### 4. Selected areas

- Satisfaction of the Educational Community Stakeholders,

- Quality of Educational Service Teaching practices, assessment and curricular articulation; Class Directors, Psychology and counseling services and The Special education teachers: impact of their actions.
- Management and Leadership satisfaction of the school community: guidelines and decisions made, relationships with people, conflict resolution
